Sherri volunteers at the PODER Learning Center and helps fellow residents get the resources they need for effective medical coverage and other health concerns. She also volunteers with the

kids in the Golden Youth Alternative Program. Sherri is one neighbor that believes in the positive changes in the community. She wants to go back to school and is working with the Texas Department of Assistive and Rehabilitative Services to achieve her goals.





- Have Tiller, Will Loan Residents who wish to plant a garden in their yards may check out a tiller! There are a few rules and conditions. Contact the Service Coordinator at your site for more information.
- Stray Cats We have many stray cats, especially at Allen Woods. Please remember that if you feed them, you are assuming ownership of them and will be subject to the Housing Authority rules regarding pets such as security deposits and vaccination requirements. We know it is hard but please resist the temptation. Do not provide food and water. They will go somewhere else. We set out traps provided by Animal Control from time to time. Remember, feral cats can carry rabies. The treatment for possible exposure to rabies is unpleasant and expensive. Cats also spread fleas and fleas spread disease. Yuck.
