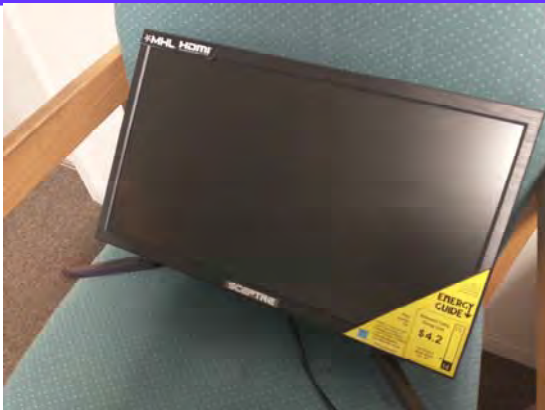

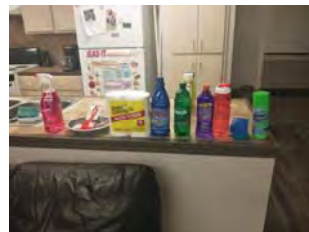


# Springtown Villa
